Each patient will be allocated a limited amount of time, to receive the flu jab only – please do not ask the clinician for any other items, such as prescriptions during this clinic. All patients should wear a mask when entering the surgery premises. Please come alone unless you need support.

You should only attend the clinic if you are well. If you have/have had any symptoms of Coronavirus in the 14 days up to your appointment date – a new cough, high temperature, or loss/change in taste or smell – please cancel your appointment and re-arrange.
