Patient feedback from annual survey

Patients completing our annual patient survey can leave feedback. Here are some of the most recent comments:

"I think antibiotics should be carefully monitored"

Practice Response: The surgery works with our local Clinical Commissioning Group pharmacist to monitor the use of antibiotics. We run annual audits and follow local & national guidance to ensure we are up to date on prescribing of antibiotics.

"I work in Birmingham so find it hard sometimes to pre-book late appointments"

Practice Response: We do have weekday appointments until 5.30pm and offer Saturday morning appointments for those patients who are unable to visit us in the week.

Patients who are registered for online services can pre-book appointments with a GP up to one week in advance.

"Improve; review your recall letters (for chronic diseases). They cost money to send and are sent unnecessarily i.e. after I have attended my appointment"

Practice Response: We have an annual recall system for all patients with chronic diseases (diabetes / asthma, chronic obstructive respiratory disease). Sometimes there can be a delay in sending out recall letters so they can 'cross-over' with a patient appointment. We are reviewing our recall system to try & ensure it is accurate & kept up to date.

"Should open on a Wednesday afternoon - why do you close?"

Practice Response: The surgery has always closed on a Wednesday afternoon. This is done to allow for:

- GP meetings where Partners discuss patients, services and clinical issues
- Meetings with fellow professionals e.g. Multi-disciplinary teams / Health Visitors / Consultants etc. Not only do these meetings provide the opportunity to meet professional colleagues, they also allow GPs to ask advice on patient & clinical issues.
- Training updates. With requirements to complete mandatory and statutory training it is an opportunity to arrange relevant training sessions.
- Team meetings. With all our staff working part-time, it is the only opportunity we have to gather all the team together to have protected time

Feedback from patients does not currently indicate a need to open on a Wednesday afternoon as well as Saturday mornings.

As a CQC 'outstanding' practice (January 2016). It was noted that having weekly meetings (on a Wednesday afternoon) underpinned the high level or service and care we give our patients.
