# Raffle

- Funds raised would go towards equipment. Practice had suggested a new auroscope (for new FY2 Doctors we are now training) but Glennis Portsmouth has kindly donated her husband's auroscope (& some other pieces of equipment). HJ asked PPG if they would contribute towards an aneroid sphygmomanometer. This is a manual type of BP monitor used to measure blood pressure, composed of an inflatable cuff to collapse and then release the artery under the cuff in a controlled manner & used in conjunction with a stethoscope. **PPG members happy with this option**

- Peter mentioned 'access to medical records'. Could we ask this question but as this service only became 'live 'in April 2016, we think it may be best to promote the service this year & then ask in survey next year.

### **National GP Survey Results**

- These were circulated to PPG in July & RB asked for this to be an agenda item. Concerns over some of the comments / results. Scored highly in most areas but low against some neighbouring practices, which PPG find surprising (especially following our CQC 'outstanding' rating).
- Full report at <u>https://gp-patient.co.uk/</u>. RB has paper copy
- This is a national survey sent out to random patients who may not have even visited the surgery in recent times. Unable to influence the results & very much IT based (i.e. results collated & reported on by an IT system). This is why we continue to do our own annual patient survey as we can target those patients who actually use our services on a regular basis.

### Virtual PPG involvement

- BY thinks we have approx. 8 patients on virtual PPG (checked after meeting & we have **ten** members). Contact them periodically for feedback on patient survey / leaflets / new services etc. Approx. 50% of members do respond. PPG happy with this process. No changes for now.
- BY always asks retired PPG members to be on the virtual PPG

## PPG Membership

- Discuss ways to improve membership (& diversity of the group)
- Ideally need some younger members. Have done displays / promotions in the past but not had a positive response. Do patients think it is a big commitment?
- PPG to try & engage with patients on 'Flu Saturday' to try & raise PPG awareness & membership.

- Another local surgery has used text messaging to invite potential members. PPG would like to try this for the younger age group (18 25yrs) initially. Could include a web link to our PPG page on Arden website. **BY to work** on a draft text message & then seek GP & PPG approval.
- How many patient mobile numbers do we have? **BY to check**
- PPG to encourage patients (on Flu Saturday) to make sure we have their up to date mobile number.
- Discuss use of Parish Magazine but have done this before & it may just target the 'older' age group.

## Training Practice update

- FY2 Doctor (Dr Asante) started in August & with us until December. Positive feedback so far.
- Next FY2 due in December
- Still waiting on update from NHS Property Services on providing us with more clinical space
